**EXTENSION OF PROCLAMATION DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY
IN THE TOWN OF HERTFORD, NORTH CAROLINA**

TOWN-WIDE STATE OF EMERGENCY CURFEW

Just to be safe, the curfew is extended until 11:59pm, Thursday, September 24, 2020, with the message that Hertford citizens should "be cautious and stay aware of their surroundings".

The curfew extension provisions are:

- Children and youth below the age of 18 are to be off the streets from 4:00pm to 5:30am.
- Adults 18 and over are to be off the streets from 10:00pm to 5:30am.

The exceptions are for scheduled doctor appointments, childcare, school and employment. Visits to the store, gas stations and to pick-up prescriptions should be done during non-curfew hours.

The proclamation of the curfew extension is in effect as of September 22, 2020 and shall remain in effect until 11:59pm Thursday, September 24, 2020. The police are enforcing the curfew.
