Attachment A: Probable Cause for [REDACTED] West Chamberlain Avenue, Hampton, Virginia, 23663.

On October 29, 2021 at 1542 hours, Hampton Police responded to [REDACTED] West Chamberlin Avenue in the City of Hampton for an unresponsive 1-year old female with the initials [REDACTED]. Medics responded and transported [REDACTED] to Hampton Sentara Careplex Hospital. Doctor [REDACTED] advised Detective S. Wells (WELLS) that [REDACTED] injuries consisted of a subdural bleed, swelling to the left side of the brain, and a blown pupil. [REDACTED] was transported to the Children's Hospital for the King's Daughter (CHKD) for surgery.

According to the child's custodian, [REDACTED] she was at her neighbor's house and her husband [REDACTED] was watching [REDACTED] at their residence located at [REDACTED] West Chamberlin, when one of her juvenile children ran over and told her to come home right away. [REDACTED] states when she returned home, her husband [REDACTED] was holding the baby who did not look right. She then called 911.

Hampton Police Officer Franklin (FRANKLIN) was standing by with [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] West Chamberlin Avenue. While doing so, saw text messages being exchanged between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. These text messages indicate that [REDACTED] intended to provide false information to the police. [REDACTED] was discovered to have an active warrant for his arrest and was placed into Hampton Police custody.

WELLS conducted an interview with [REDACTED] during which he indicated he found [REDACTED] unresponsive and attempted to, "Shake," her awake.

While conducting the investigation, WELLS received a phone call from CHKD Nurse R. [REDACTED] regarding [REDACTED] status. [REDACTED] indicated that [REDACTED] suffered massive trauma and is likely to succumb to her injuries.

This affiant is a Special Victim Unit Investigator and has received approximately 100 hours of training regarding the investigation of child abuse and neglect. Based on this affiant's training and experience, children suffering from abuse are likely to vomit, bleed, urinate, or defecate as a result of their injuries. This affiant is requesting a search of the two story, single family dwelling located at [REDACTED] West Chamberlain Avenue, Hampton, Virginia, 23663; for the items listed in Section 3 of this affidavit.
